

CROPPING AN IMAGE IN MICROSOFT OFFICE


- 1. Select a Clip Art graphic from the Clip Art gallery.
- 2. Insert the Clip Art graphic into your document (presentation, spreadsheet, etc.).
- 3. Select the graphic (you should see the handles around the graphic).



4. If you do not see the picture toolbar (floating toolbar) when you select the image, right-click the image. Then select the option to **Show Picture Toolbar**.




5. The Picture Toolbar should appear.



NOTE: The Picture Toolbar allows you to change the brightness, contrast, orientation, color, compression, line style (around the image), etc. as well as crop the image.

The **Crop** tool allows you to cut, snip, or eliminate parts of the image.

6. Select the image, and then select the **Crop** tool **i** (in the middle of the Picture Toolbar).



7. Place your mouse on one of the edges. Then click and drag to crop the image.
